

1976

Offering & groceries collected for needy families inspire 3 churches at a Thanksgiving Worship Service to start a Food Pantry & Clothing Closets.

2006

Six area churches collecting & distributing food, clothing & linens; 44 bags of groceries given to 24 families.

2007

MCEF incorporates as a 501(c)3 non-profit charity. \$17K of financial assistance given to 84 families.

2011

Pantry serving 351 families = 1,119 people
\$41.6K of financial assistance to 212 families

2013

Pantry renovations: floor, shelves, counter, decking, refrigerator & HVAC!

Business office established at Shalom Baptist Church



2014

Senior Rides expands to Ashland; now Hanover Senior Rides - 117 rides covering 2,501 miles.
MCEF Website and Facebook pages refreshed.
\$68.7 of financial assistance to 200 families. Eligibility changed to once in 3 years.

2015

Hanover Senior Rides - 348 Rides covering 9,965 miles
\$53.8K of financial assistance to 185 Families
Food Pantry offering fresh eggs & bread; now serving 398 families = 1,257 people

2016

Hanover Senior Rides - 522 rides covering 14,812 miles
\$53.3K of financial assistance to 136 families
Food Pantry gets a new roof! Serving 450 Families - 1,431 people
Helping provide food to fill backpacks for the Weekend School Lunch Program
200 volunteers provide 20,000 hours of service!
One-Stop Shop Square Foot Sponsor building fund program launched
