Senior Rides

This program provides transportation to medical appointments, the grocery store, the bank and other personal business for seniors age 60+ who cannot drive themselves.

Seniors who need a ride, call our Ride Coordinator with the details of their need. The Coordinator will schedule the trip with a driver and call the rider back.

Seniors must be ambulatory, but may use a cane or folding walker for stability. We are not equipped to accommodate wheelchairs.

We rely on volunteer drivers who use their personal vehicle to transport riders. All drivers are qualified through background checks and driver safety training. MCEF provides liability insurance coverage.

Services Provided in 2020

Direct Financial Assistance of \$50,011 to 107 families for:

Electricity, Water, Rent, Fuel Oil, & Prescriptions

The One Stop Shop served 350 households (1,026 people):

(The OSS was closed for 3 months due to COVID-19)

2,215 bags of food

636 bags of clothing

79 bags of linens

\$9,365 was used to purchase:

- Groceries like fresh eggs, canned chicken, dish detergent, socks, underwear & sheets.
- The Mechanicsville Weekend Backpack Program served 76 children in 6 schools & received 1,675 lbs. of food from the OSS.

Hanover Senior Rides gave 1,338 rides to 93 riders!

This ministry provides rides to the doctor, bank, and grocery store for senior adults who cannot drive themselves.

- ◇ Receptionist - verify & update client information; register new clients
