

1976 Offering & groceries collected for needy families inspire 3 churches at a Thanksgiving Worship Service to start a Food Pantry & Clothing Closets.

2006 Six area churches collecting & distributing food, clothing & linens; 44 bags of groceries given to 24 families.

2007 MCEF incorporates as a 501(c)3 non-profit charity. \$17K of financial assistance given to 84 families.

Food Pantry serving 351 families = 1,119 people
\$41.6K of financial assistance to 212 families
